\*\*Improvement is based on NCQA national standards tracked since program enrollment. Decreases in hypertension management reflect an influx of new patients receiving this care. Results are expected to increase with continued access to medication for these patients.

**10,000+ treatments provided and counting!**

In 2020, the Savings Lives with Medicines Program exceeded 10,000 treatments provided since the 2017 launch! These treatments represent critical access to life-saving chronic and acute medications for underinsured and uninsured people across Southeast Georgia.

As clinic partners continue to provide care on the frontline of the coronavirus pandemic, the Saving Lives with Medicines Program continues to support clinics with relief supplies including infrared thermometers, masks, face shields, and gloves.
